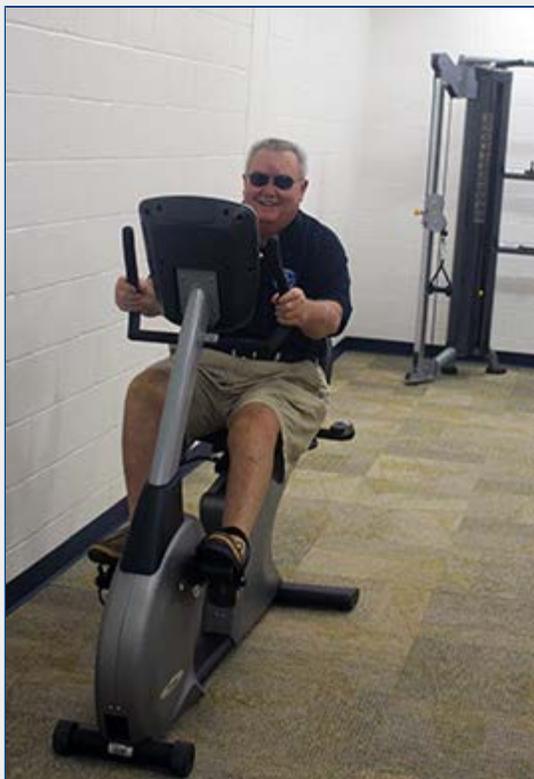

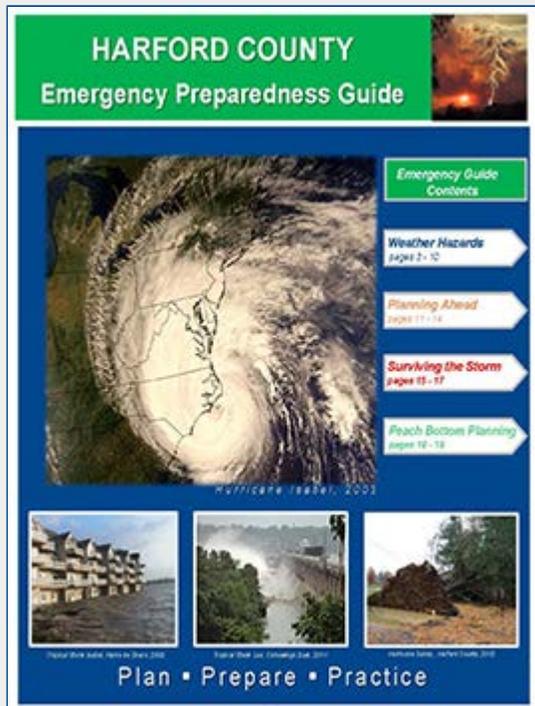

Winter weather safety

With this season's early snowfalls and several days of freezing weather, now is a good time to review our winter weather safety tips. Avoid over exertion in cold weather and please check in on the elderly and other vulnerable populations. Maintain proper ventilation when using kerosene heaters to avoid build-up of toxic fumes; and in case of a power outage, never run a generator inside your home. Just in case ... Harford County's Snow Plow Tracker

During major snowstorms, you can track the location of county snow plows with our Harford County Snow Plow Tracker app. Activated when snow reaches six inches or more, the tracker shows the location of our GPS-equipped plows on county roads using an online map updated every 15 minutes.
